Thank you again for your time and resolution regarding student Catherine Aguilera Vasquez (#3012048). For open record and internal tracking, we respectfully summarize:

- **Compliance Confirmed:** Graduation requirements were met, as verified in your final audit.
- **12 Emails Total:** This case required 12 back-and-forth emails to resolve what appears to be a manual audit miscalculation.
- **System vs Manual Discrepancy:** Our biometric SMART system calculates hours automatically, reducing human error. We trust this will serve as a helpful reference to prevent future audit issues.
- **April 2025 System Duplication:** A duplication issue affecting 40+ students was formally reported (attached: "Data Duplication Concern in ML1 – 05/06/2025"). We kindly request your technical team review this unresolved concern.
- **Future Audit Readiness:** We've adopted your recommendation to provide separated monthly biometric reports for students and instructors moving forward. We hope KBC audit staff will also feel free to reach out directly for clarification at any time.
- **Signature Line Updated:** We took your feedback about our signature language to heart and have already made appropriate updates, in line with your guidance. As part of our school culture — *quick communication, elevate each other, adopt and adapt* — we welcome such recommendations.
- **Respect for the Board:** We treat the Kentucky Board as a partner in licensing and public service. We are here to support clarity and student success.
- **Response Track Record:** We consistently responded within 2 hours or less to all Board inquiries, and remain committed to open and timely communication.

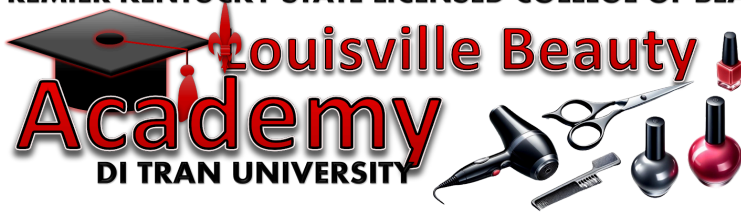

Good morning,

We have received your email and will clarify all information will be included in the official Board record for August 11th as we are fully transparent with our Board members and all involved entities.

For the duplicate posting of hours, that is not possible for our system to conduct such. Hours are only submitted when the ML1 account user submits those. It does not automatically submit hours, nor

duplicates. Upon speaking with company representatives, if it were ever a system error, it would have occurred for every submission, not just one specific school or student.

I have personally gone through the audit and recalculated the SMART logs and our database. I have attached the totals for verification.

Your May SMART system log was 116.22 and your submission of 116.25 rounded was correct.

Your June SMART system log was 106.54 hours, and your submission was 90.50 hours which was an under report of 16.05 hours for that student which reflected in KBC's system that they had not met the 450-hour graduation requirement, which brought about this student audit.

Now that a full audit for Ms. Vasquez has been completed, and 459.30 biometrically indicated, we have processed her graduation.

To ensure future accuracy, all requested student hours or audited hours must be submitted to us for each student with each month separated and calculated by your system, along with the Instructor's biometric time clock as well.

For example, if bio metric report for a student such as this instance is requested, you must submit a report for March, April, May and June dates separately with the SMART system totals for each month on the report.

And report the same request for the instructor's during that period as well.

Thank you for your cooperation and compliance in this manner and we will ensure all documentation is presented on your behalf.

Thank you for confirming that the student meets graduation requirements. We respectfully submit the following legal clarifications:

📄 Duplicate Posting – 138.50 Hours

The duplication originated within the **KBC system**, not our school. We previously notified the Board of this issue. We did **not submit those hours twice**.

📅 May 2025 Hours – 116.25

Our biometric SMART Time Report confirms **116.22 hours**, matching the 116.25 submitted. We request the Board audit team to **recalculate using the full SMART logs**. A manual miscount may have occurred. → Screenshots and system totals have been reattached for verification.

📅 June 2025 Hours – 90.50

We accept this was **underreported intentionally**, as the student voluntarily completed more than required. The biometric record confirms **106.54 hours**.

We respectfully request that these clarifications be included in the official Board record for August 11. We maintain full compliance and transparency.

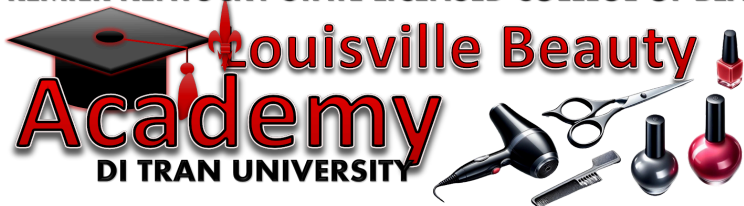

Good afternoon school representative and **Louisville Beauty Academy – Public Relations and Legal Team,**

Thank you for your communication regarding the discrepancy in student hours between the KBC reporting system and Louisville Beauty Academy's biometric time records.

Following an internal investigation and a thorough review of the hours submitted, we identified several reporting inconsistencies that led to the discrepancy:

1. Duplicate Posting:

Hours for May 5, 2025 were submitted twice—once on May 5 and again on May 6, 2025. This resulted in a duplicate total of 138.50 hours, which caused an inflated count of 581.75 hours in our system. Which reflects the screen shot and edits you attached. After removing the duplicated hours (138.50), in which you submitted on two different dates, the corrected total in the KBC system reflects 443.25 hours.

2. Incorrect May Hours Posted:

On June 9, 2025, you submitted May hours totaling 116.25. However, the biometric time clock records only calculate to 108.43 hours for that period, meaning an **overreporting of 7.82** hours for the month of May.

3. June Hours Underreported:

On June 25, 2025, you reported 90.50 hours for June. However, the biometric record for that month shows the student actually achieved 106.54 hours. **16.04** hours were **underreported** for the student in June.

Summary of KBC's review: After removing the duplicate entry and correcting the discrepancies, Louisville Beauty's reported hours to KBC totaled 443.25 hours. However, that reported time failed to reflect the biometric time clock, which indicates the student completed 451.28 total hours. The student meets the requirements to graduate from the program.

Please take note – KBC has documented these incorrect reports filed by Louisville Beauty. A report will be presented to the KBC Board at the August 11th, 2025 board meeting for consideration. Remedial measures and appropriate disciplinary action may be decided on this date.

Your signature line says "Public Relations and Legal Team" – which implies an attorney is bcc'ed in the communications, as you are not an attorney. If you have retained counsel, please advise so KBC staff can specifically include her or him in the communications. Thank you for your time and attention to this matter, and for your continued support of accurate student reporting and graduation eligibility.

As a supplemental note to our already submitted formal response and documentation regarding student Catherine Aguilera Vasquez (#3012048), we respectfully share one additional observation that has emerged during our internal audit.

System Date Discrepancy – May 2025 Submission

We have identified a concerning mismatch between our official log submission date and the date currently reflected in the KBC system.

- The **May 2025 hours total (116.25)** was finalized, reviewed, and submitted by our team on **June 7, 2025**, as per our system timestamp.
- However, the KBC interface reflects the entry with a “**Date Completed**” of **May 9, 2025** — a full three weeks earlier.

! We respectfully question how a May total could be legally or procedurally posted on May 9th — before the month even concluded. This raises significant concern about either system-side auto-filling, backdating, or data corruption.

We have attached a screenshot (*LBA-CatherineAguileraVasquez-KBCHoursDateStampDiscrepancy.png*) highlighting this discrepancy, showing our correct internal log date alongside the KBC system date.

Legal and Procedural Integrity

Louisville Beauty Academy does **not submit month totals before month-end**, as doing so would violate proper tracking and legal reporting standards. Our systems are timestamped, cross-verified, and protected against unauthorized back-entry.

We share this not as a challenge, but as a **legal and professional duty** to ensure that student records are preserved and presented with full accuracy — especially when discrepancies may cause confusion or audit flags later.

Closing Note

We respectfully ask the Board to **review this date stamp discrepancy internally** and advise us of any technical cause or correction. We remain committed to full cooperation and compliance and deeply appreciate your time and continued oversight.

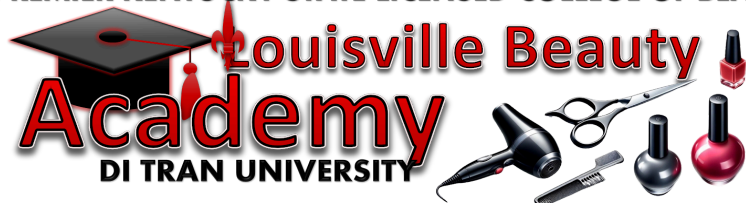

This marginal rounding difference reflects system formatting only. The logged attendance is accurate and consistent. A timestamped screenshot of this match is included (*May2025-Audit-ConfirmedCorrect.png*).

✓ **June 2025 – Logged Hours: 90.50 (Voluntary Additional Attendance = 106.54 hours)**

Catherine Aguilera Vasquez voluntarily completed **106.54 total hours** in June, though we conservatively posted 90.50. This is consistent with our school's longstanding culture of:

- Encouraging students to **go above the minimum hour requirements**
- Ensuring **on-time graduation eligibility**
- Accounting for any future KBC audits or system reconciliation

This approach reflects a student's personal responsibility and planning — not an overstatement or posting error.

A screenshot and biometric report (*June2025-Audit-ConfirmedCorrect.png*) clearly confirms the 106.54 clocked hours.

🔒 **Compliance Integrity and Final Position**

Louisville Beauty Academy's monthly logging system is deliberately designed to prevent submission errors. We maintain:

- Real-time biometric logging via SMART Systems

- Monthly internal hour validation and screenshot backup
- Direct verification by our compliance team before submitting to KBC

This case reflects the integrity of that system. The original submission for Catherine Aguilera Vasquez — made on **June 25, 2025 at 11:32 AM** — is fully accurate, supported by evidence, and **requires no correction**.

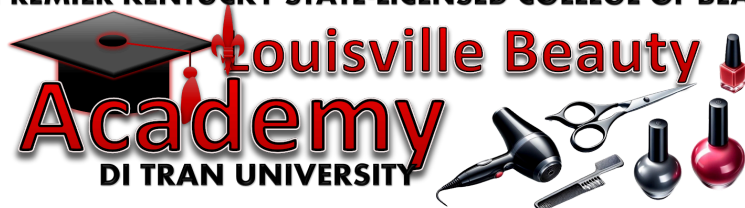

Upon full internal audit, we confirm that Catherine has completed **450 hours and more**, ensuring a sufficient buffer—as is common practice among our students. Catherine, like most of our students, voluntarily attends additional hours beyond the minimum to prevent issues related to timekeeping discrepancies or system input errors.

The attached SMART Time Activity Report reflects her complete and detailed clock-in/out records. The discrepancy appears to be related to a **June 2025 logging typo at graduation entry**, combined with the **manual recalculation we had to perform due to the KBC system's April 2025 duplication**, which impacted all Louisville Beauty Academy students.
